- Crafternoon- limited 12

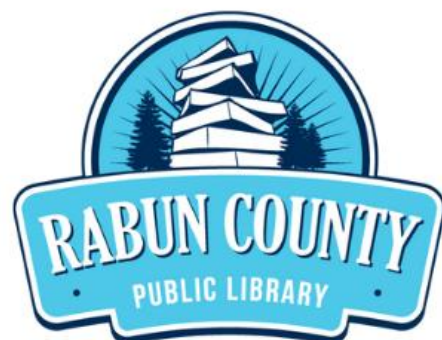
